Beta Exam

The Beta Exam is the updated exam based on the 2025 CMP-International Standards.

Participants in the Beta help determine what accounts for a passing score on the updated exam.

Benefits of Participating in the Beta Exam:

- You will be part of a group helping to shape the future of our industry and setting the bar for aspiring CMPs.
- You will also receive discounted fees and complementary access to the EIC Manual, 9th Edition and the Sustainable Event Professional Certificate programme.
- Application fee: \$350 USD
- Exam fee: \$100 USD (normally \$525 USD)
- Sustainable Event Professional Certificate complementary for Beta participants (normally \$495 USD)
- Total cost: \$450 USD

Step 3: Provide the required details to process the attendance.




Step 2: Click Upload Attendance to navigate to the upload page.

EIC is finalising a major platform upgrade that introduces several new features to streamline your workflow:

- 1. Unlimited File Uploads: There will no longer be any quantity or size limits for uploading files.
- 2. Detailed Mismatch Reports: You will receive a report of any records that do not match an existing profile on EIC's platform, enabling quick follow-up to ensure every participant gets their credit.
- 3. Automated Notifications: Participants will be automatically notified when credits are assigned to their profile, ensuring transparent communication at every step.
