

# What is an EDI Regional Ambassador?

As an extension of the Global EDI Committee, EDI Regional Ambassadors play a pivotal role in supporting MPI chapters' Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) goals by fostering collaboration with regional councils & MPI including IBOD/GBOT Leadership. They champion EDI initiatives, offer support, create content, and facilitate the dissemination of resources.



## **Collaborate with Regional Councils**

- Ensure alignment with regional councils to effectively promote MPI's EDI resources and the use of them in the chapter level.
- Work with regional ambassadors to have everyone in their region complete the training within 2 months of the start of their term.



### **Support Chapters**

- Assist chapters in integrating EDI initiatives into their operations, serving as a primary point of contact for inquiries and assistance.
- Provide recommendations to chapters looking for specific EDI presenters/topics.
- Identify chapters in regions demonstrating excellence in EDI work and elevating them as best practice examples, inspiring others to adopt similar strategies.



#### **Provide Resources**

- Collaborate with the EDI Global Advisory Committee to develop and deliver a mandatory training video for chapter leaders, slated for rollout in 2025.
- Partner with MPI Global to promote initiatives aimed at encouraging members to provide demographic information, establishing a baseline for measuring progress such increasing the number of chapters with EDI committees.
- Lead and engage in MPI EDI community page.



#### Leadership and Recognition

- Actively promote the Social Impact Award within chapters, advocating its consideration through various training programs, events, collaborations, and initiatives.
- Identify and nominate deserving chapters, clubs, or student organizations for their outstanding contributions to social impact and EDI advocacy.
